1 INTRODUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 Introduction

The courses studied as part of the University Certificate may be used for articulation or credit against future study, however this University Certificate is not a qualification under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

These University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program Regulations apply to all students enrolled in the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program at the University of Notre Dame Australia.

These Regulations should be read in conjunction with the University's General Regulations.

1.2 Interpretation

The terms included in these Regulations have the meanings as defined in the University's General Regulations.

1.3 Amendments made to Program Regulations

Unless otherwise specified, when amendments are made to the structure, content or academic requirements of the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program, the amendments will automatically apply to all students enrolling for the first time in the Program in the year immediately following the adoption of the amendments.

1.4 Applicability to Campuses of the University

The University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program is available on the Fremantle Campus only.

2 ENTRY CRITERIA

- 2.1 The standard entry criteria as detailed in the General Regulations apply to the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program.
- 2.2 The University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business is available only to Study Abroad students studying at the University.

3 AWARD REQUIREMENTS

3.1 Structure

The structure of the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business is annexed as Appendix A.

3.1.1 Compulsory Courses

ARTS3750 Australian History and Society 25 units of credit

BUSN3070 Business in Asia 25 units of credit

PLUS

HIST2021 The History & Politics of Southeast Asia OR
GEOG2010 Asia-Pacific: Culture and Environment 25 units of credit

PLUS:

Two elective courses 50 units of credit

3.1.2 Elective Courses

Students must select their elective courses from the Study Abroad Course Guide and Syllabus published on a semester by semester basis and as approved by the Dean of the relevant School and the Pro Vice Chancellor International.

3.1.3 Majors

There are no Majors within the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program.

3.1.4 Minors

There are no Minors within the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program.

3.1.5 Specialisations

Specialisations are not available within the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program.

3.2 Practicum or Internship requirements

There are no practicum or internship requirements associated with the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business Program.

3.3 Approved Course substitutions

Course substitutions are only permitted with the approval of the relevant Dean (or delegate) and the Pro Vice Chancellor International.

3.4 Volume of Learning

3.4.1 Standard Duration

(i) The standard duration of the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business is 0.63 years of equivalent full time study.

(ii) Students are not able to enrol in the degree on a part-time basis.

3.5 Graduation

A minimum of one hundred and twenty five (125) units of credit drawn from the approved program structure and completed in one (1) semester of study is required in order for a student to graduate with the University Certificate in Asia Pacific Business.
