CHAPTER 1: INTRODUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

1.1 Introduction

The units studied as part of the University Certificate may be used for articulation or credit against future study, however this University Certificate is not a qualification under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

This University Certificate in International Studies Course Regulations apply to all students enrolled in the University Certificate in International Studies Course at the University of Notre Dame Australia.

These Regulations should be read in conjunction with the University General Regulations.

1.2 Interpretation

The terms included in these Regulations have the meanings as defined in the University's General Regulations.

1.3 Alterations made to Course Regulations

Unless otherwise specified, when amendments are made to the structure, content or academic requirements of the University Certificate in International Studies Course, the amendments will automatically apply to all students enrolling for the first time in the course in the year immediately following the adoption of the amendments.

1.4 Applicability to Campuses of the University

The University Certificate in International Studies Course is available on the Fremantle and Sydney Campuses.

CHAPTER 2: ENTRY CRITERIA

- 2.1 The standard entry criteria as detailed in the General Regulations apply to the University Certificate in International Studies Course.
- 2.2 The University Certificate in International Studies is available only to Study Abroad students studying at the University.

CHAPTER 3: COURSE REQUIREMENTS

3.1 Structure

The structure of the University Certificate in International Studies is annexed as Appendix A.

3.1.1 Compulsory units

There are no compulsory units within the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.1.2 Elective units

- (a) Students must complete five (5) elective 25cp units within the same semester from the list of unit offerings recommended for Study Abroad students and approved on a semester by semester basis published in the Study Abroad Academic Handbook for each of the Fremantle and Sydney Campuses.
- (b) A student may only enrol in an approved Study Abroad unit where the pre-requisite and/or co-requisite units have been satisfied.

3.1.3 Majors

There are no Majors within the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.1.4 Minors

There are no Minors within the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.1.5 Specialisations

Specialisations are not available within the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.2 Practicum or Internship requirements

There are no practicum or internship requirements associated with the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.3 Approved unit substitutions

Unit substitutions are only permitted with the approval of the the Pro Vice Chancellor International in consultation with the Dean of the relevant School(s).

3.4 Course duration

3.4.1 Standard Duration

- (i) The standard duration of the University Certificate in International Studies is 0.63 years of equivalent full time study.
- (ii) Students are not able to enrol in the degree on a part-time basis.

3.4.2 Accelerated Duration

An accelerated mode is available for the University Certificate in International Studies Course.

3.5 Graduation

A minimum of one hundred and twenty five (125) credit points drawn from the approved course structure and completed in one (1) semester of study is required in order for a student to graduate with the course University Certificate in International Studies.
