# 1 INTRODUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

## 1.1 Introduction

The units studied as part of the University Certificate may be used for articulation or credit against future study, however this University Certificate is not a qualification under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF).

This University Certificate in International Studies Program Regulations apply to all students enrolled in the University Certificate in International Studies Program at the University of Notre Dame Australia.

These Regulations should be read in conjunction with the University General Regulations.

## 1.2 Interpretation

The terms included in these Regulations have the meanings as defined in the University's General Regulations.

## 1.3 Amendments made to Program Regulations

Unless otherwise specified, when amendments are made to the structure, content or academic requirements of the University Certificate in International Studies Program, the amendments will automatically apply to all students enrolling for the first time in the Program in the year immediately following the adoption of the amendments.

## 1.4 Applicability to Campuses of the University

The University Certificate in International Studies Program is available on the Fremantle and Sydney Campuses.

## 2 ENTRY CRITERIA

### General Criteria

- 2.1 The standard entry criteria as detailed in the General Regulations apply to the University Certificate in International Studies Program.
- 2.2 The University Certificate in International Studies is available only to Study Abroad students studying at the University.

### 3 AWARD REQUIREMENTS

#### 3.1 Structure (Appendix A)

The structure of the University Certificate in International Studies is annexed as Appendix A.

##### 3.1.1 Compulsory Courses

There are no compulsory courses within the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

##### 3.1.2 Elective Courses

- (a) Students must complete five (5) elective 25 units of credit courses within the same semester from the list of course offerings recommended for Study Abroad students and approved on a semester by semester basis published in the Study Abroad Course Guide and Syllabus for each of the Fremantle and Sydney Campuses.
- (b) A student may only enrol in an approved Study Abroad course where the pre-requisite and/or co-requisite courses have been satisfied.

##### 3.1.3 Majors and Double Majors

There are no Majors within the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

##### 3.1.4 Minors

There are no Minors within the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

##### 3.1.5 Specialisations

Specialisations are not available within the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

#### 3.2 Practicum or Internship requirements

There are no practicum or internship requirements associated with the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

#### 3.3 Approved Course substitutions

Course substitutions are only permitted with the approval of the Pro Vice Chancellor International in consultation with the Dean of the relevant School(s).

#### 3.4 Volume of Learning

##### 3.4.1 Standard Duration

- (a) The standard duration of the University Certificate in International Studies is 0.63 years of equivalent full time study.
- (b) Students are not able to enrol in the degree on a part-time basis.

##### 3.4.2 Accelerated Duration

An accelerated mode is available for the University Certificate in International Studies Program.

#### 3.5 Graduation

A minimum of one hundred and twenty five (125) units of credit drawn from the approved Program structure and completed in one (1) semester of study is required in order for a student to graduate with the University Certificate in International Studies.
